Who the modules are for:

Living Faith modules are open to any Christian who would like to learn more about their faith. The student group will include those training as Lay Pastoral Ministers, Licensed Evangelists and Readers in the Diocese of Peterborough, as well as members of other churches.

Keeping a portfolio

Everyone taking a *Living Faith* module will be encouraged to keep a portfolio of work. This could take a variety of forms - a video diary, an essay, a letter, an audio recording, etc. Where course staff feel that the portfolio has the potential to be awarded University credits at Level 1, the student will be given the option to pursue this.
