OM4 Introduction to Church history

The sessions in this module will cover:

- an introduction to the main the main periods, developments and issues in the development of the Church through history, including the first twelve centuries, the Middle Ages and the Reformation, the era of revolution 1645-1900 and the 20th and 21st centuries
- a more detailed examination of the English Reformation and the development of Anglicanism
- aspects of the social, cultural and global context within which the Church developed
- implications of a study of Church History for understanding the Church and the context of our ministry today.

Who the module is for

Living Faith modules are open to any Christian who would like to learn more about their faith. You need not have done any academic study before but you will need a reference from your church minister or a tutor who has taught you recently to say that they would benefit from study this level. The student group will include those training as Lay Pastoral Ministers, Licensed Evangelists and Readers in the Diocese of Peterborough, as well as members of other churches.

Keeping a portfolio

Everyone taking a *Living Faith* module will be encouraged to keep a portfolio of work. This could take a variety of forms - a video diary, an essay, a letter, an audio recording, etc. Where course staff feel that the portfolio has the potential to be awarded University credits at Level 1, the student will be given the option to pursue this.
