## OM7 Ethics - Responding to Moral Issues

### The sessions in this module will cover:

- a framework for examining ethical issues and help participants understand a variety of Christian approaches.
- The role of Scripture and the role of God in relationship to moral issues faced today will be examined.
- Consideration will be given to issues around birth, mid life and dying.
- Participants will be invited to use their own context as a basis for reflection.

Participants will have the opportunity to look at an issue in detail and report back on their findings.

### Who the module is for

*Living Faith* modules are open to any Christian who would like to learn more about their faith. You need not have done any academic study before but you will need a reference from your church minister or a tutor who has taught you recently to say that they would benefit from study this level. The student group will include those training as Lay Pastoral Ministers, Licensed Evangelists and Readers in the Diocese of Peterborough, as well as members of other churches.

### Keeping a portfolio

Everyone taking a *Living Faith* module will be encouraged to keep a portfolio of work. This could take a variety of forms - a video diary, an essay, a letter, an audio recording, etc. Where course staff feel that the portfolio has the potential to be awarded University credits at Level 1, the student will be given the option to pursue this.
