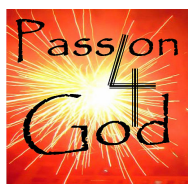

Saul/Paul erupts onto the scene at the martyrdom of Stephen in the book of Acts, chapter seven when 'the witnesses laid their coats at the feet of a young man named Saul.' Yet there are few more significant figures in the New Testament, a book which would incidentally be briefer and impoverished without his contribution. These evenings offer an introduction to the sweep of this extraordinary man's life, teaching and influence. Paul is a towering figure and well worth getting to know!
