

In the Peterborough Diocese we take safeguarding children and vulnerable adults very seriously.

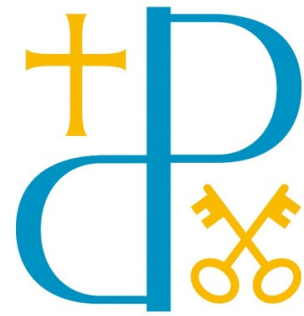
