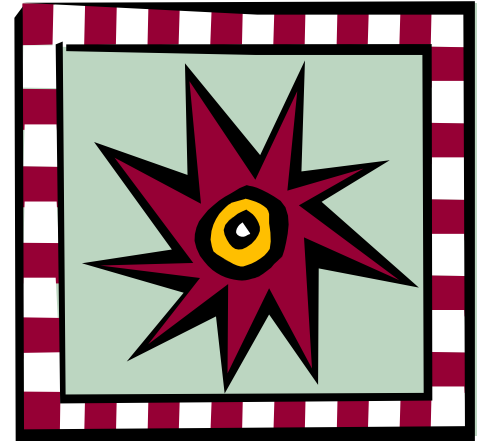

He works as the Southwell and Nottingham Diocese Children's Ministry Adviser, speaks at lots of churches and conferences, and writes books and songs. He is particularly passionate about all-age church, and why boys hate church, and in his spare time he's a trustee of Scripture Union and a Magistrate.

What else?

Godly Play: There will be two Godly Play taster sessions during the morning which offer the chance to observe and share a story. These provide a good chance to find out about the wonder of Godly Play if you have not come across it before or to see an enthusiastic practitioner, Lizzie McWhirter, as storyteller. In the afternoon, Lizzie will lead a full Godly Play session (across 2 workshop slots) to allow 20 people to participate. These 20 places will be allocated before the day so email gillian.spokes@peterboroughdiocese.org.uk if you wish to apply for this specialist option. It is likely that the session will be oversubscribed, so preference will be given to pairs of people coming from the same benefice, and to people who have never enjoyed a full Godly Play session before.

Worship: We will open our day together with worship.

Networking: There will be plenty of opportunities to network with other children's leaders over coffee and lunch, and in the workshops.

Good news: We will again be collecting "Good News" of what is going well in parishes. The Children's Work Cup will be awarded to one of the 4 parish projects that have been nominated for 2010.

Marketplace: There will be a Marketplace for you to buy resources, including the delightful puppets from One Way UK, under 5s resources from Minty Hen, as well as a bookstall. Make sure you bring cash or cheques with you for your purchases.

Bringing your children: We cannot offer a crèche on this occasion, but you are welcome to bring your children with you (free of charge). We suggest that you choose workshops that they will find of interest such as the Godly Play taster, puppets, crafts, music or faith in the family.
