Away From it All (AFIA) is a holiday scheme funded by members of Mothers' Union, to help people who otherwise wouldn't be able to have a holiday.

The holidays may take many different forms.

Some are more suitable for families, others for individuals.



Who is eligible for AFIA breaks?

The scheme is open to anyone who is experiencing stress in their family life. You don't have to be a member of a church or any organisation. You can apply for yourself or on someone else's behalf. If you apply for yourself or your family, a member of the clergy, doctor, headteacher or social worker will be asked to support your application. We will need some basic information, such as when you last had a holiday, and the reason why you would like a break. There will be a simple application form to fill in.



Whilst we could not provide holidays during the period of Covid Lockdown, our AFIA coordinators used AFIA money to support and encourage marriage and family life in other ways. By being creative, we were able to fund an alternative to holidays such as holiday club placements and day trips out.


