

KEY STAGE 5 NATIONAL VOTER REGISTRATION EVENT

APRIL 16th 2024

8.40am,11am or 2pm

Young people have an important part to play in our democracy. There are so many ways that they are already positively shaping our world.

But currently young people are the least likely demographic to vote in our general elections. Of the 8 million people across the UK who are not registered to vote, a significant proportion are younger people, and this unequal participation is effectively sidelining issues that impact young people most.

We are putting on this special, live, 15-minute, online event for Key Stage 5, college and sixth-form students at multiple times during National Voter Registration Day to inspire and register your young people to vote in this year's General Election.

We will explore why voting matters, why young people's voices are so desperately needed in our political life and how they can make a difference on issues they really care about.

There will be inspiring stories, energetic and enthusiastic guests, and a live registration walkthrough.

Teachers will be able to access a step-by-step guide to supporting students through the simple, 5-minute process.

This is a non-partisan event which focusses on the important of voting and taking part in the democratic process.

Representatives of the Electoral Commission have been consulted in the design of this event.

The event will be repeated live three times on National Voter Registration Day run at 8.40am,11am and 2pm so pick the event timing that works best for you.

We are hoping to break a record for the greatest number of young people registered to vote in one day.
