Introduction

From September 2011 Peterborough Diocese is offering the opportunity for those who regularly work with children to undertake some training and receive accreditation. On successful completion of the training you will receive a Certificate signed by the Bishop which will be presented to you by your incumbent. This will give you accreditation for the work you do in your benefice.

Bishop Donald writes

It is so good when people volunteer to teach the Christian faith to children and walk alongside them in their journey of discovery. Most of us though feel the need for training and support for this sort of ministry. I am delighted the Diocese is now able to offer such training and I encourage anyone who feels they might benefit to apply for the course.

Length of training

The training can be completed in a year, but can be spread over a longer period, up to three years.

Involvement

You will do four modules (each taught over 6 evenings) and an extended project. There will be a task to complete in between sessions. You will need to complete an assignment following each module and write up your project. Before you start your training you will be expected to undertake an hour's guided observation of children in an educational setting.

Syllabus

Module 1: Introduction to Studying the Bible

This module will help you get a grasp of the content of the Bible in its context including the different types of writing, the particular role of the Old and New Testaments, and a variety of ways of "reading" the Bible. Insights into how to study Bible texts will be gained as one Old Testament book and one New Testament book are examined. Consideration will be given to how this applies to working with children.

Module 2: Core Skills for Children's Work

This module will explore specific skills for children's ministry. It will help you to develop your understanding of children and the skills required to nurture children in their journey of faith. It will help you to develop a vision of a Christian community in which children's faith is expressed and valued

Module 3: *Gospel and Community in the New Testament and Today*

This module will look at how the early Christians approached the issues thrown up by the society in which they were placed, and examine how this understanding can help you in supporting children within today's society in which they are placed.

Module 4: *More Skills for Children's Work*

This module will build on the work done in Module 2 and look at specific situations including children with special needs, the transitions children experience, behaviour and children's advocacy.

Project

You will agree a specific project to work on with the course leader and your incumbent. This will include the aims of your project; you will write up the project evaluating the extent to which those aims have been met.

The four modules will be taught between September and April each year. The project will be done between May and July.

Cost

The cost of the course is £100. Your parish will be invoiced for this.

Applications

You need to have the support of your incumbent and your PCC. You will need a reference from your incumbent and another member of your church.

Oversight

The Certificate is run by the Adult Education Team working with the Children's Missioner
