Local Policy Statement-
Priority for the allocation of grant-aid to capital
projects

The number and value of capital projects in Voluntary Aided schools outstrip the grant-aid available. In prioritising projects for grant aid, the Diocesan Board of Education will give preference to those project which:

1. Address Health and Safety risks to pupils or staff
2. Repair and Maintenance items in line with AMP
3. Provide permanent class base accommodation for pupil where schools are facing increased numbers of pupils through agreed planned development
4. Provide permanent class base accommodation for pupils currently in mobile units
5. Provide suitable accommodation to deliver the full national curriculum
6. Provide suitable accommodation for worship
7. Provide adequate staffroom and Headteacher office accommodation
