Reviewing plans your own context and in light of regulations to think about what can and can't be done.

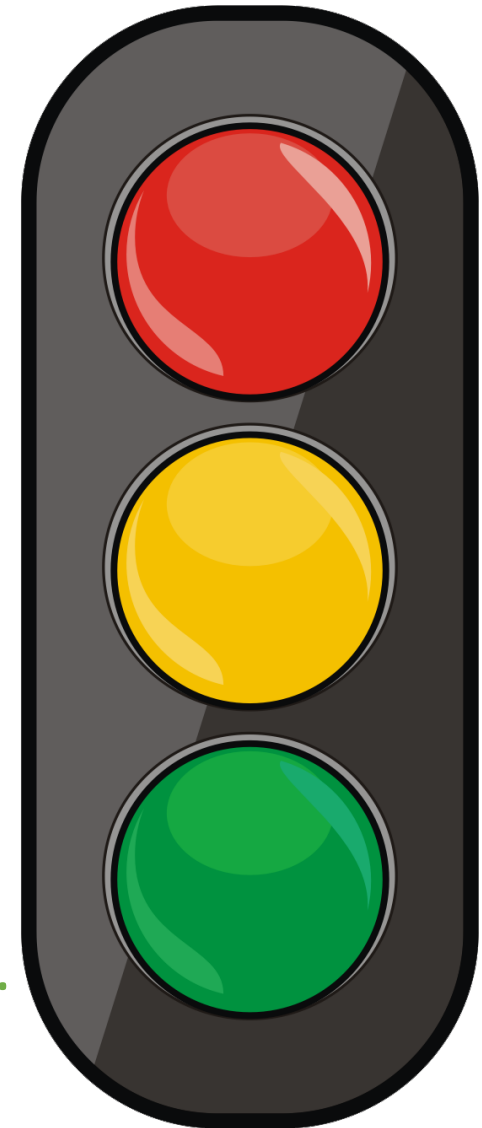
Involving others early in order to facilitate this and plan moving forwards.

# Traffic Light Planning

Green – Can go ahead and be publicised- will happen regardless of Covid situation. *Do these things really well!*
