

Thank you for considering one of these new posts in the Greater Northampton Deanery

The new Incumbent of the Living Brook Benefice will also be the Incumbent of St Mary the Virgin, (Far Cotton) Northampton. These posts will be held in plurality.

It is envisaged that the incumbent will focus particularly on Hardingstone and Far Cotton and will live in the Vicarage at Hardingstone. An Assistant Priest, Revd Sylvia Coles, is already in place at Far Cotton.

Meanwhile, a House for Duty priest will be appointed to look after the villages of the Living Brook Benefice. The House for Duty priest's duties would include leading worship and chairing/attending PCCs at Piddington and Quinton, providing pastoral care in the villages, being a visible clergy presence especially at village events, and building constructive relationships with Hackleton School.
