The sessions in this module will

- offer an exploration to the background of the New Testament and its theology, through examination of particular texts
- offer help in understanding these texts in their historical, sociological and literary context, relating them to contemporary contexts
- offer an examination of the particular purpose and character of each of the four Gospels with a detailed examination of Matthew, Luke/Acts and John
- offer an introduction to the writings of Paul

The first five sessions will give an overview of the New Testament and an introduction into its theology, with examination of particular texts. In the final session you will work in a small group on a specific text and present your findings.

Who the module is for

Living Faith modules are open to any Christian who would like to learn more about their faith. You need not have done any academic study before but you will need a reference from your church minister or a tutor who has taught you recently to say that you would benefit from study at this level. The student group will include those training as Lay Pastoral Ministers, Licensed Evangelists and Readers in the Diocese of Peterborough, as well as members of other churches.

Keeping a learning journal

Everyone taking a *Living Faith* module will be encouraged to keep a learning journal of work. This could take a variety of forms – a video diary, an essay, a letter, an audio recording, etc.
