The sessions in this module will cover:

- an introduction to the main periods, contexts and issues in the Church through history, including the Patristic period, the Middle Ages and the Reformation, the establishment of the Church of England 1532-1700, and the revolutions of 20th and 21st century culture and society
- a more detailed examination of the formation of an Anglican identity
- aspects of the social, cultural and global context within which the Church developed, and the ways in which it sought to interact with them
- implications of a study of Church History for understanding the church and its mission today

Is the module is for me?

Living Faith modules are open to any Christian who would like to learn more about their faith. You need not have done any academic study before but you will need a reference from your church minister, or a tutor who has taught you recently, to say that you would benefit from study at this level. Your student group will include those training as Readers in the Diocese of Peterborough, as well as members of other churches.
