

C2 Safeguarding Leadership

Who is this module for?

Required for anyone who has safeguarding leadership responsibilities or responsibility for leading activities with children/young people or vulnerable adults, including but not limited to:

- Safeguarding leads on PCC
- Churchwardens
- Bishops Visitors.
- Parish Safeguarding Officers
- Spiritual Directors
- Pastoral Visitors
- Bell Tower Captains
- Parochial Lay Workers (if not already eligible for this or another training module)
- Ordinands if not completed prior to TEI
- Directors of Music
- Choir Leaders
- Youth Work Leaders

Intended learning aims and objectives

The aim of this course is to equip parish officers to embed healthy parish safeguarding practice and to explore the roles and personal vulnerabilities of parish officers in implementing parish safeguarding procedures and responding to serious situations.

By the end of this module you will be able to:

- List key statutory sector partners and know how to contact those relevant to your current work.
- Name diocesan/TEI/Cathedral partners, including the Diocesan Safeguarding Adviser or equivalent
- Describe diocesan safeguarding processes for responding to serious safeguarding situations, responding to children and adults (including survivors) and referral to other agencies; managing posers of risk and review of safe working practices.
- Demonstrate the accurate recording and safe storage of safeguarding information.
- Undertake an annual audit and review of parish safer working practices
