

REFRESHER SAFEGUARDING TRAINING PROGRAMME

JANUARY 2020 – DECEMBER 2022

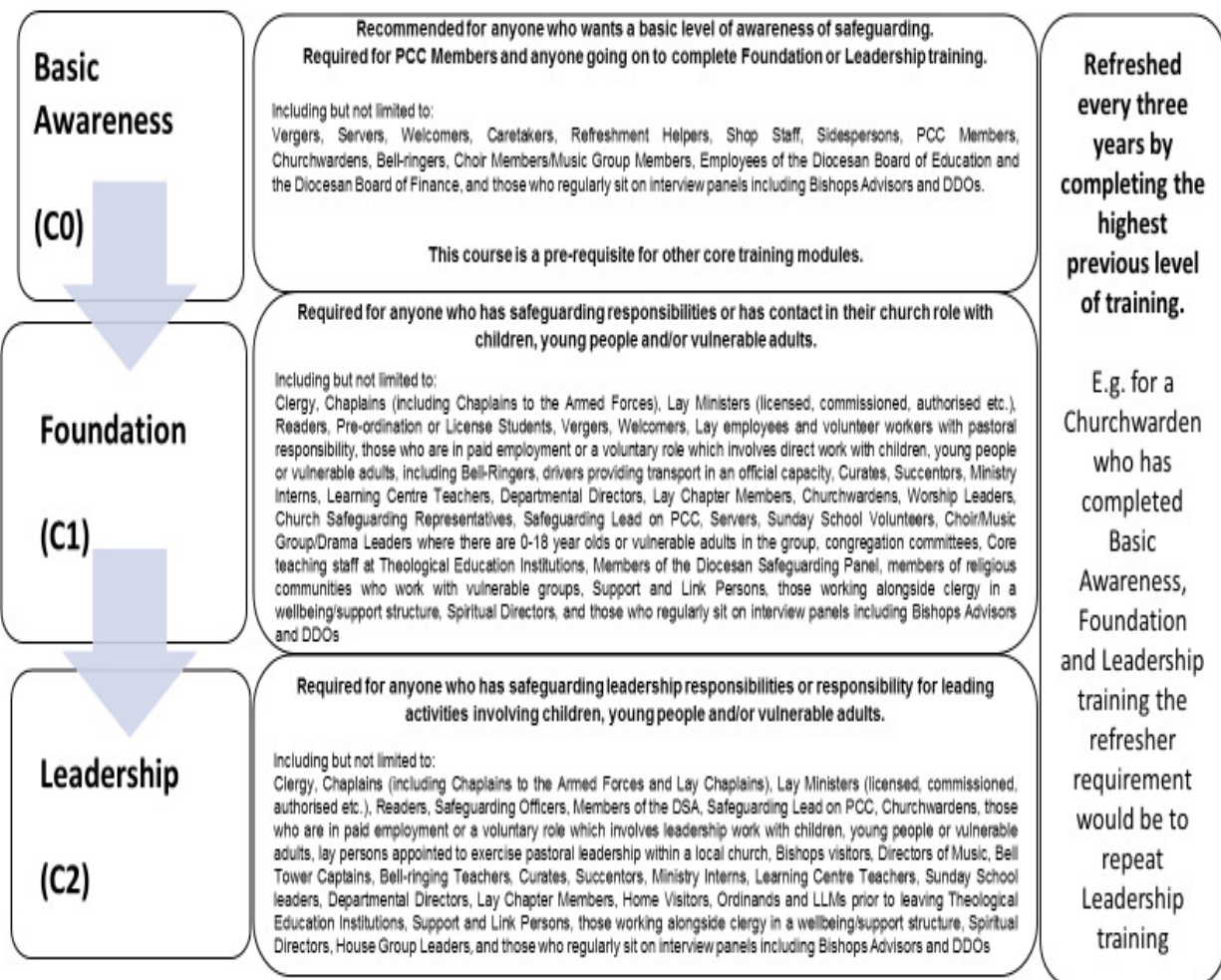
The Diocese of Peterborough is committed to the safeguarding, care and nurture of everyone within our community. A healthy Christian community is one which ensures and nurtures the wellbeing of all. Safeguarding needs therefore to be embedded in all aspects of the life and ministry of the Church, and safeguarding training and development is seen in this context. Active engagement with safeguarding training supports all those who have a role within the Church to effectively recognise and respond to possible abuse and implement best safeguarding practice.

Safeguarding training is to be completed every three years. The next three-year training programme has now been devised and sets out how the Diocese of Peterborough and Peterborough Cathedral intend to implement the training strategy for 2020 – 2022, commencing early 2020.

The Church of England’s Practice Guidance: Safeguarding Training & Development, published in July 2019, provides the framework for safeguarding training across all Church of England communities. This also sets out the core safeguarding training modules which are a mandatory requirement for particular church roles (please see below). The training requirements set out are very ambitious and the programme for 2020 – 2022 is designed to achieve a balance between the various competing priorities we are working with.

The following table outlines the training modules that are available as part of the Diocesan Training Strategy for 2020 - 2022.



There are additional core safeguarding modules for clergy and senior clergy: one is The Ministry of Reconciliation (The Seal of the Confessional) and the other is C4 – Safeguarding Training for Senior Leaders.

The specialist modules that are part of the training strategy are: S1 – Safer Recruitment (which will be on-line) and S3 – Responding to Domestic Abuse. The DSA will incorporate S3 into the C2 training module

Safeguarding Modules

There are three core modules of ‘refresher’ safeguarding training: C0, C1 and C2.

The Diocese of Peterborough Safeguarding Training Programme includes information about **on-line** and **face-to-face** safeguarding training options.

1. C0 Basic Awareness and C1 Foundation Safeguarding Training

Volunteers who do not have a leadership role and are not licensed by the Bishop will need to complete C0 or C1 training, depending on their role. These modules are on-line or will be delivered by a Diocesan (or Cathedral) volunteer safeguarding trainer. These modules can be completed in the following way:

C0 and C1 on – line:

- Log onto the Church of England training portal and complete the on-line training module. At the conclusion, a certificate of completion will be emailed, which is to be shown to the Parish Safeguarding Officer (PSO), Cathedral Safeguarding Officer (CSO) or clergy
- Someone who has completed the training can log onto the Church of England portal, with a group, and complete the training together. Details of: who attended the training, and the role and parish they are from, are to be sent to Sharon Welbourne, so that Diocesan and Cathedral training records can be updated. Certificates will be provided either prior to the training or after completion of the training

C0 and C1 face-to-face

- Contact Sharon Welbourne and arrange for a safeguarding volunteer trainer to provide C0 face-to-face training to a group. Details of: who attended the training, and the role and parish they are from, are to be sent to Sharon Welbourne, so that Diocesan and Cathedral training records can be updated. Certificates will be provided either prior to the training or after completion of the training

2. C2 Leadership and S3 Responding to Domestic Abuse - combined Safeguarding Training

These modules are for all who hold the Bishop's licence or are volunteers who have a leadership role. This module will be face-to-face training, delivered by the DSA and Assistant DSA.

NB: For Clergy and those with PtO who have not completed C3 or C1 and C2 training there are no more C3 training courses. You will need to complete C1 module (as above) and then attend C2 face-to-face training
